The VI Mediation in Dialogue Colloquium, to be held on May 26, 2021, deals with a current and emerging theme for contemporary society, bringing Mediation for Human Rights into the 21st century for discussion. In an increasingly globalized world, social challenges arise that demand an adaptation of daily practices in favor of Human Rights. Mediation, as a practice of social regulation, has assumed a predominant and active role in responding to these challenges by providing educational spaces for empowerment, education and learning.
